CONDITIONS & REGULATIONS

1. The Competition will be open to Amateur members of recognised Golf Clubs with a handicap of 5 or less under the Handicapping Scheme of the Council of National Golf Unions. Entries will be limited to 54 and if over subscribed, there will be a ballot of the higher handicaps.
2. **Entries close on Monday 19th July 2010.**
3. The Competition Committee will make the draw, and the order and starting times will be posted to each competitor. All unsuccessful entrants will be advised. In the event of a competitor having to scratch, no entry fee will be returned.
4. A tie for 1st place will be decided on "Sudden Death"; all other ties will be decided by count back over the last 18, 9, 6 or 3 holes etc.
5. Competitors are advised that both rounds are **qualifying rounds** for handicap purposes and those whose handicap has been altered between the date of entry and the competition will advise the Secretary of such alteration.
6. The Competition Committee reserve the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason for their action. All disputes will be referred to them for their decision, which will be final.
7. Dress Regulations will be relaxed for the lunchtime period, but all competitors will be required to observe Dress Regulations after they have completed the afternoon round.

Please Note: If shorts are worn on the course they must be of a respectable length and worn with long stockings. Boxer shorts and cut down garments are not acceptable. Shorts may not be worn in the Dining Room.
8. The Entry Fee includes morning coffee, lunch and a light tea.

PRACTICE ROUND

Competitors will be given courtesy on any one day during the week prior to the competition (i.e. week commencing 26th July).
