# Inaugural Mid-Amateur Open 36 Hole Open Scratch Medal Wednesday 2nd October 2019

### Conditions & Regulations

**Entries:** 

The Competition will be open to Amateur golfers over the age of 35 that are members of recognised Golf Clubs with an active handicap of 9 or less under the Handicapping Scheme of the Council of National Golf Unions. Entries may be accepted from entrants exceeding the handicap restrictions however, these competitors will play from the upper limit stated.

Entries will be limited to 40 and if over subscribed, there will be a ballot of the higher handicaps. The closing date for entries will be Wednesday 18th September after which the Competition Committee will complete the draw, starting sheets will be sent to all entrants and unsuccessful entrants will be notified by e-mail. No entry fees will be refunded once starting sheets have been sent out.

Format: 36 holes (Scratch Medal) on the Old Course played from the White Tees. A tie for 1st place will be decided by count-back over the last 18, 9, 6 or 3 holes etc.

> Competitors are advised that both rounds are qualifying rounds for handicap purposes and those whose handicap have been altered between the date of entry and the competition will advise the Secretary of such alteration.

**Prizes:** Scratch and Handicap Voucher prizes. No player may take more than one prize.

**Practice Round:** Competitors are permitted to play a courtesy round between Monday 23rd and Friday 27th September, subject to availability. Competitors are asked to make arrangements with the office beforehand on 01342 822018.
